



# I-20 Frontage Road Conversion

 Texas Department Of Transportation - Abilene District

## Overview

Later this year, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will begin a project to reconstruct and convert I-20 frontage roads to one-way operation, relocate ramps, and make other improvements along some of the busiest parts of the corridor. Construction won't begin until the second half of 2012, but the changes and improvements will be significant. This project has been identified as a priority by the Abilene Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO). The MPO works with local, state and federal transportation agencies as well as the public to determine regional transportation goals and projects.



*Project detail: I-20/SH 351 intersection improvements, including U-turns, pedestrian and bicycle facilities.*

## Project Facts

- Project limits: Pine Street to Loop 322 (4.4 miles)
- Convert frontage roads from two-way to one-way
- Relocate ramps (see map above)
- Add U-turns at SH 351
- Add sidewalks, bike lanes
- Project bidding begins summer 2012, construction in following months
- Approximately 24 months to complete
- Estimated cost: \$11.3 million

## One-way frontage road benefits

- Smoother traffic flow
- Improved safety at entrance & exit ramps
- Improved intersection safety & efficiency
- Helps make frontage roads uniform statewide
- Meets driver expectations by bringing consistency to local frontage roads



### Getting around during construction

Construction zones will have signs, markings and other traffic control to help drivers navigate the area throughout the project. TxDOT will provide construction updates to local media. 
